#### **PATRONAL FEAST DAY / SPORTS DAY – FRIDAY 29<sup>TH</sup> JUNE**

We will be celebrating the feast day of St Peter and St Paul with Mass in St Peter and St Paul Church at 9.30 am. This will be followed, after lunch, by our annual Sports Day.

There will also be a raffle on this day held in aid of our chosen charity for the year, Guide Dogs for the Blind. Please support this very worthy cause.
