Christmas Lunch

This year we will be serving Christmas lunch on Wednesday 18th December to our students and staff. To enable our catering department to prepare and serve this there will be no other food served at lunchtime. However students **will** have the opportunity to purchase food at break time. Students **will not** be permitted off site to purchase lunch from local shops.

The cost of our Christmas lunch is £4.00 and tickets **must** be purchased. For those pupils who have a cashless catering account, the cost of the lunch will be taken from the account when they request a ticket. For those who do not have a cashless catering account, cash may be used, please give your payment to Mrs Betley, Catering Manager. Tickets are available from the canteen.

If your son / daughter is entitled to free school meals and would like a Christmas lunch then he / she will still need to collect a ticket from the canteen (no payment will be required for the amount in excess of the free school meal entitlement). If your son / daughter does not want a Christmas lunch then a packed lunch will be provided, however they **must** make this known to the canteen before **Monday 9th December**.
