Coronavirus Update:

We are sure you are keeping abreast of the situation as regards what is now considered a pandemic. We can confirm from official channels that, as of yesterday, there was still only one positive case of coronavirus in Lincolnshire.

You will however be aware that the government has moved from the 'contain' phase to the 'delay' phase of their action plan. Part of this plan involves reducing movement of the public and it may involve shutting schools, colleges and nurseries, currently we have been advised that schools will stay open. We must emphasise that the government will advise schools if and when to shut and we will follow that advice. We will not shut before then and we will not remain open if advised to shut.

We are obviously mindful of protecting the education of your child as far as possible so our subject leaders have been working on home-study plans to ensure learning can continue should the school close. We understand that we may not get much notice of a closure requirement but equally we do not wish to cause any unnecessary panic. Please ensure your child is able to access the school website (student area) to access any home study projects set. We advise during a home-study period students should allocate their time evenly across the subjects by essentially following their normal timetable or daily school routine, doing this will also ensure they retain valuable recreation time in moderation and take breaks.

Any families without internet access will be able to contact the school in order to receive further study guidance for their child.
