Children of key workers

Yesterday the Prime Minister announced that schools will close with effect from the end of the school day on Friday 20th March 2020 for all pupils apart from the most vulnerable and children of key workers.

Throughout the last few weeks, we have followed the Government's guidance on how to respond to the Coronavirus and been active supporters of the strategy to combat the Coronavirus crisis.

In order to support key workers and the contributions they can make to fighting the spread of the virus, St Peter and St Paul Academy will be keeping our school open for your children. If you work in the following sectors, you are considered a key worker and you will be able to keep sending your child/children to their usual school, to enable you to continue to work.

Key workers: Subject to confirmation from the Cabinet Office

- Armed Forces Personnel
- Firefighters and other related staff in the Fire and Rescue Services
- Local Authority staff (Environmental Health Officers, Planning officers etc)
- NHS workers involved in clinical work such as doctors, nurses, paramedics, ambulance drivers
- Police officers, including Community Support Officers and some civilian staff
- Prison Service Staff and Probation Service Staff
- Social Workers, Educational Psychologists and Therapists employed by Local Authorities or NHS
- Teachers and Nursery Nurses
- Delivery drivers
- Highway Agency Staff.
- Ministry of Defence Staff.
