For those families who will not have children attending school we will support families with learning by providing work that can be accessed through the school web site, through the student area and then by clicking on Sharepoint.

We wish to remind parents and students of our E-Safety policy which is on our web site. We have been through a special information session with all students today, to remind them how to keep themselves safe, including numbers they can call if they need additional support.

Whilst your children are using the internet at home, please ensure that you are vigilant and where possible you use child filter systems. Talk to your children about what they are looking at or who they are talking to and the possible risks that could be connected to this.

Please remember that the school will be open so you can telephone or email and we will try and answer any queries or questions you might have and help where we can.

If you have a safeguarding issue or issues of hardship because of Covid -19 situation you should make contact with school or with Lincolnshire Children's services on 01522 782111 (Monday to Friday, 8.00am to 6.00pm) or 01522 782333 (outside Office hours). Our Designated Safeguarding Officer's (Mr Wilkinson) contact details are on the home page of our website. Additionally, other helplines are on our website to support our students.

Normally if a child brings an on-line bullying issue into school we have to investigate as stated in the Keeping Children Safe in Education guidance, with Government policy stating 'All forms of bullying (including cyberbullying) should be handled as a community issue for the whole school.' To report any concerns remotely please contact the Designated Safeguarding Officer for the school. If you deem this a criminal offence, please contact your local police team.
